AGREEMENT

Applicant and the City of Citrus Heights, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as the "City", agree as follows:

1. This Agreement is part of the consideration for the issuance by City to Applicant of an alarm system permit pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 30, Sections 26-75 of the Citrus Heights City Municipal Code.
2. This Agreement is entered into by both parties in conformance with Chapter 30, Division 2, Section 66 of the Citrus Heights City Municipal Code.
3. Applicant agrees to reimburse City for the costs incurred by City resulting from excessive false alarms emitted by Applicant's alarm system. "Excessive" false alarms are those set forth in City of Citrus Heights Resolution No. 2006-76.
4. City and Applicant agree that the exact costs incurred by City for excessive false alarms are difficult to ascertain and, for that reason, the amounts set forth in City of Citrus Heights Resolution No. 2006-76 are agreed upon liquidated damages.
