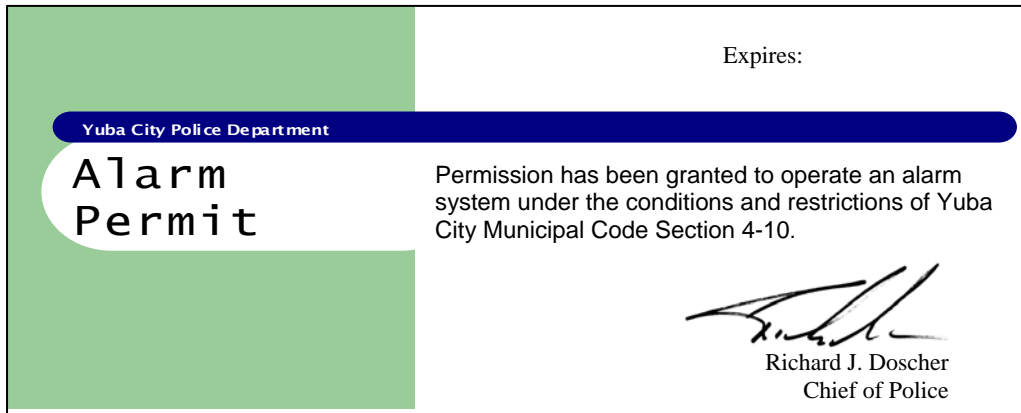

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## NOTICE TO ALARM PERMIT APPLICANTS

(Revised 05/21/07)

Yuba City Municipal Code 4-10 regulates burglary and robbery alarms, authorizes imposition of permit fees, and establishes fees for false alarms. Every person who has an alarm must file an application for and receive a permit from the Chief of Police. The fee for the initial permit is \$28.

Restrictions and regulations of the permit are as follows:

1. The permit shall be issued to the person who is in legal possession of the property protected by the alarm.
2. The permit cannot be transferred (between individuals or properties) without the written consent of the Chief of Police.
3. The permit may be revoked for any violation of YCMC 4-10 when the alarm activates 5 false alarms within any 90 day period or failure to pay any service fee within 30 days of billing.
4. The permit holder will be charged \$61 for the third false alarm to which the department responds within any 90 day period. The charge for the fourth false alarm is \$122; the fifth false alarm is \$183; and \$244 for each additional false alarm during a 90 day period.
5. The permit, once issued, is valid for 2 years.
6. The renewal fee is \$28 and is valid for 2 years.
7. Audible alarms must have an automatic shut-off that deactivates the sound after 15 minutes. Alarms which emit a siren or automatically dial the Police Department **are not permitted**.
8. Alarm permits are subject to reasonable conditions imposed by the Chief of Police.
9. The permit holder must notify the Police Department immediately of any changes in the information contained within the application which occurs after the permit is issued.
